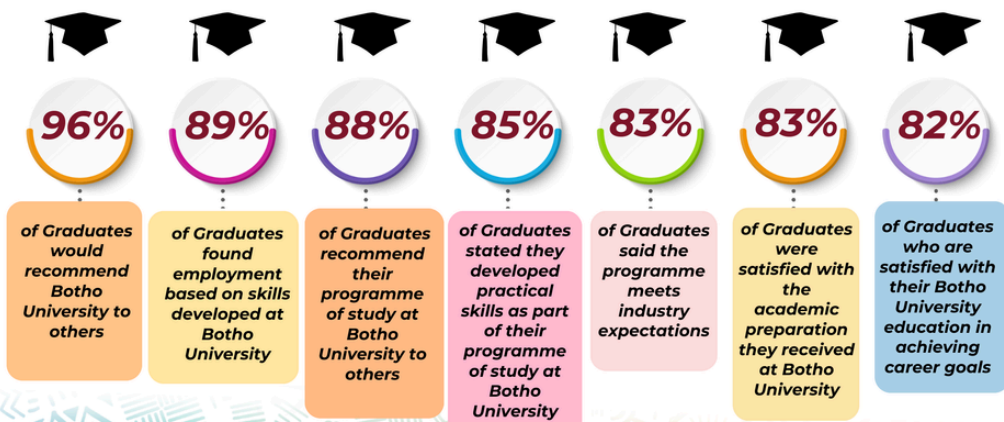

Botho University is an approved tuition provider for this program. The program has been delivered in parts, namely the Certificate Level, the Operation Level, the Management Level and finally the Strategic Level. The last three levels have four papers each including a paper on case study. A student will generally take between four to five years to complete this course. On completion of the program the incumbent will be given a Chartered Global Management Accountant (CGMA) designation.

The curriculum consists of essential core modules and elective modules that are optional. Specific modules may require prerequisites, requiring students to successfully complete another module or set of modules before registering. Additionally, certain modules may be designated as co-requisite, meaning they must be taken concurrently. The credit load of each module is indicated by the number in parentheses at the end. Each credit is equivalent to approximately 10 hours of combined guided, in-class, and independent learning. Hence, a module with 10 credits generally involves around 100 hours of study.

With the continued growth of the Eswatini campus, SAAD plans to expand the scope of its counseling services to help students cope with any challenges they may be facing.

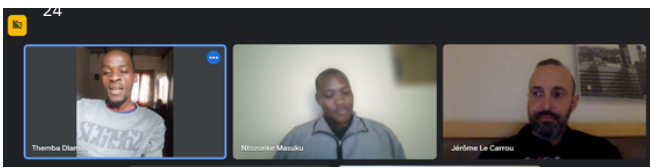
