



Terms and Conditions for the Prizes for Botho University Graduate Tracer Study 2026

As part of Botho University's ongoing commitment to enhancing the educational experiences of our graduates, the university invites eligible graduates to participate in the 2026 Graduate Tracer Study project. The insights gained from the survey will significantly enhance existing initiatives targeting graduate employability and research.

The Graduate Tracer Study 2026 requires eligible graduates to complete the Tracer Study Survey, which will be emailed to them. For Botswana and Lesotho campus eligible graduates, the survey will be emailed to their Botho University email address. For Online campus graduates, the survey will be emailed to the email address in university records.

To show its appreciation for participation, Botho University is pleased to announce a unique scholarship opportunity where everyone stands a chance to win. Please take note of the following terms and conditions:

1. Eligibility:

- a. All Botho University graduates who successfully **completed** their programme of study in December 2024 from Botswana, Lesotho, and the Online Campus are eligible to participate in the 2026 Graduate Tracer Study Survey.
- b. "Completed programme of study" means that they wrote their final exams successfully in December 2024. This should **not be** confused with when the graduate attended their graduation ceremony.
- c. Both undergraduates and postgraduates are eligible to participate.
- d. Only one entry is allowed per Botho University graduate as per eligibility.

2. Lucky Draw for Master's Scholarship:

- a. Every eligible graduate who completes the Graduate Tracer Study will automatically be entered into a lucky draw.
- b. 100 lucky winners will be randomly selected to receive a 75% scholarship to pursue a Masters's programme at Botho University. (**Tc and Cs apply.**)
- c. Final decisions on the winners are strictly approved by the Scholarships Committee.
- d. All scholarships mentioned throughout this document are strictly applicable only for Masters degree programmes for which the university is enrolling under the Botho

University Online Learning campus at the time that the scholarship is available. No undergraduate programme on any other campus of study is eligible.

- e. Winners of scholarships must meet the eligibility criteria as mentioned in this document and all admissions requirements of the Master's programme of study

4. Application Deadline:



- a. The Graduate Tracer Study 2026 will remain open until **the closing dates are communicated as per the official communication by Botho University on official communication channels.**

5. Scholarship Redemption:

- a. Scholarship recipients must enrol at Botho University within six months of being officially notified about the scholarship; otherwise, the scholarship will expire, and the recipient will not get any additional opportunities to utilise it.
- b. Scholarship recipients, while enrolling, are required to sign the scholarship agreement form and abide by all terms and conditions stated in the scholarship agreement form.
- c. Scholarship recipients are required to uphold and maintain a good academic record and exhibit exemplary conduct throughout the duration of their scholarship. If not their scholarship will be revoked as per their scholarship agreement.

6. Communication:

- a. Winners of the scholarship will be notified strictly via email only.
- b. Botho University does not take any responsibility for any incorrect information provided by the eligible graduate when participating, including contact information.
- c. Botho University and any of its staff will not be held liable for any decisions taken in this matter. All decisions are final in this matter and cannot be queried by anyone.
